

## Connecting a Participant to the On-Site Server

To join an exercise running on the On-Site server, first ensure you have connected your WiFi to the correct network. It will typically have the form XXXX-ON-SITE, with the default password printed on a label on the router.

The On-Site server functions identically to the online SimsUshare CTC Server, but if your computer or device has not connected yet to the On-Site server, you must first add it as a CTC Server. In SimsUshare go to the “Enter CTC (Multiplayer) Mode”.

The next screen will show the CTC servers you have available. If you have your own On-Site server listed, you can skip over the next 2 steps.

In the picture on the right, you see only the main CTC Server, but you now need to add the On-Site server (in this case, PSFAMobile). Click on the plus (+) button to add the server.

A window pops-up in which you enter the Display Name (how you want to see the server in the list) and the ID or URL (the link to your On-Site Server. In this case, our On-Site Server’s URL is <https://psfamobile.simsushare.site>. We made the Display Name “PSFA Mobile”.

Press OK and SimsUshare tries to verify it can connect to the On-Site server. When it does, you will see the Display Name you chose in the list. Click on it (1), then press Connect (2) to begin the process of joining an ongoing exercise.

You can now follow the sheet on “Conducting a Multi-Player Exercise”.
